

INTRODUCTION:

OUR TARGET POPULATION/GROUP:

This committee composed of four elected members and lead by a chairperson focuses its activities to Oroko children and youths in Georgia, USA.

OUR OBJECTIVES:

The committee has clear objectives. These include:

1. Raising funds to support the implementation of planned activities through agreed fund raising activities;
2. Raising awareness in Oroko children and increasing their knowledge on import issues (e.g. healthy eating habits, social, cultural, the environmental, etc.) through exchange visits;
3. Coordinating the production and distribution of educational materials to facilitate

communication amongst the children and parents.

AREAS OF INTERVENTION:

In an effort to reach our objectives, Oroko Children Fund Committee shall focus on the following:

1. Educational Programmes

Our educational programmes are based on the needs of the children. In formulating any of these programmes, the views of parents shall be considered and discussed in the committee before submission to the General Assembly for approval.

2. Outreach Projects

Our outreach projects are aimed supporting beneficial children initiatives outside Georgia and in developing countries.

OUR CHILDREN IN ACTION:

The committee has organized outings for the children. And during these

events the children are given the opportunity to run the program while the parents admire their children in action.

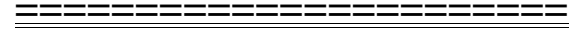
